


# **OpenOffice**.org - the project

  - >650 people and companies signed the JCA
- Almost pure Online Community




#### **Structure – Project Categories**







#### **Structure - Projects**






# **Communication – global lists**








# Native Lang Projects - focus

- Your "local point of contact"




